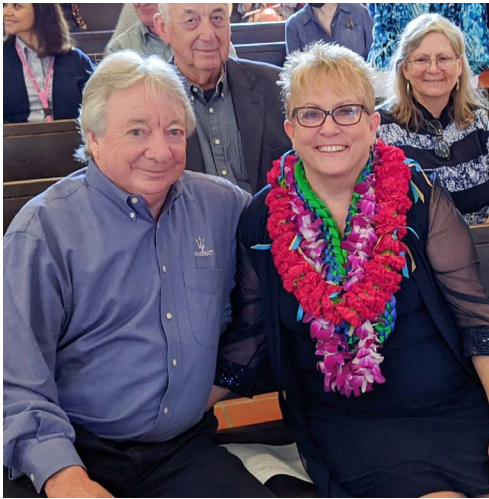

Mrs. McKenzie welcomed everyone, praised Mrs. Bennett for her many contributions, and reviewed the day's festivities. 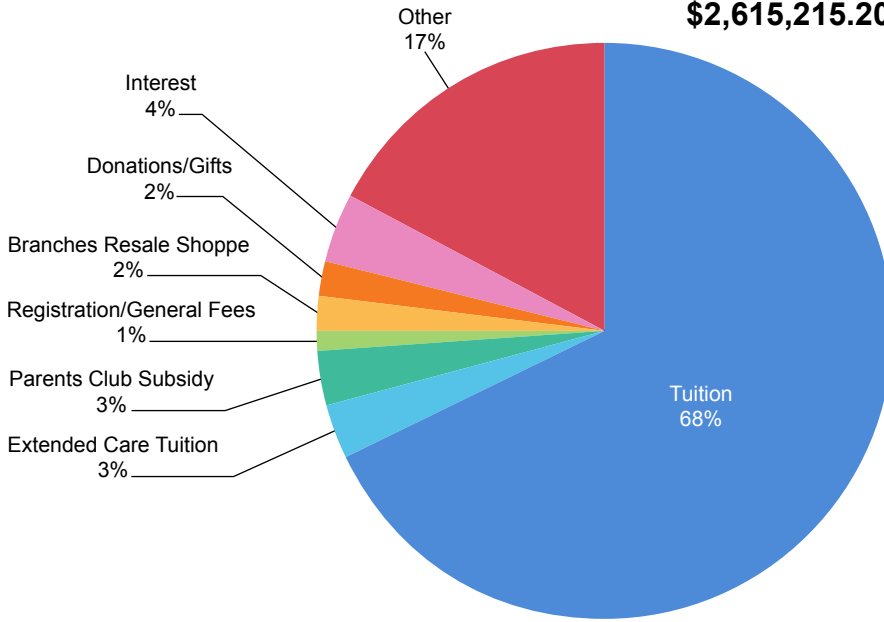

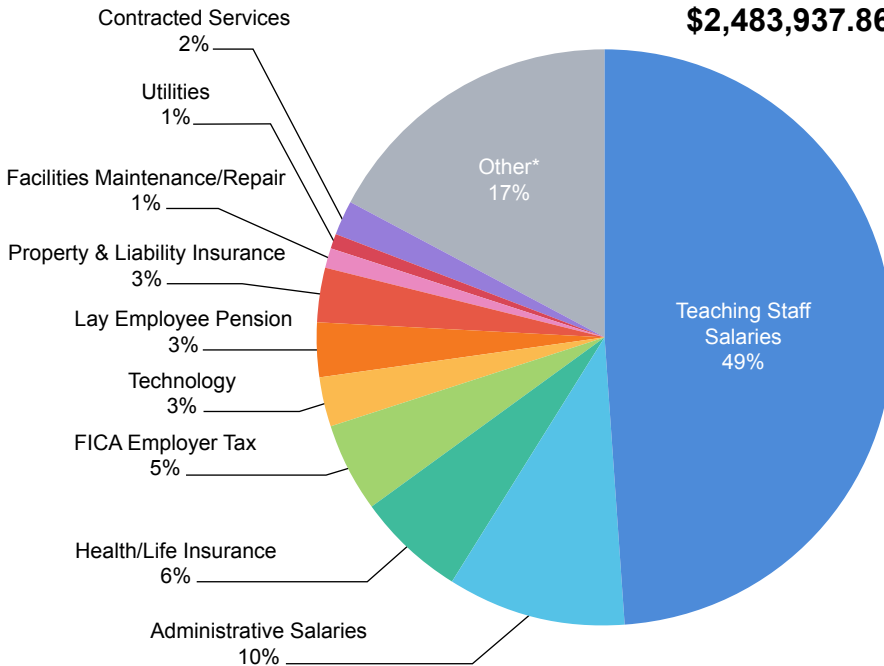

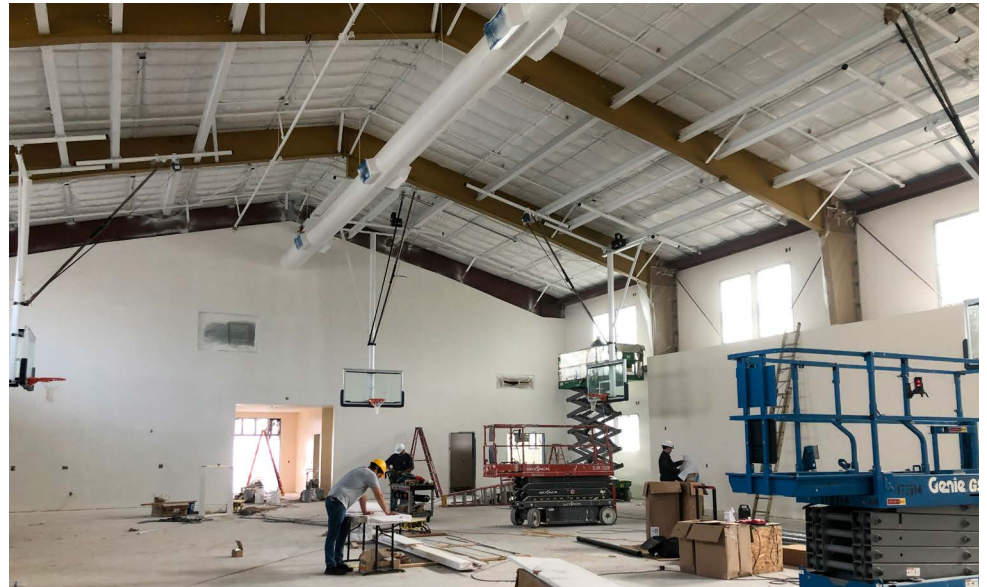

Thanks to the wonderful team effort of **Chair, Paula Calvetti and all her**

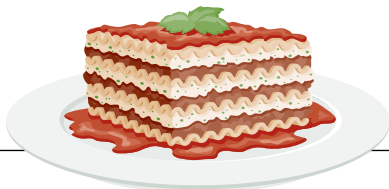
