

The Pebble Beach Company Foundation awarded SCS another wonderful grant to help fund the continuation of our Accelerated Reader Program for Grades 1-8, a new Tynker Premium Coding Plan for Grades 4-8, and new Anatomy in Clay Learning System Curriculum Materials for Middle School.

The William McCaskey Chapman & Adaline Dinsmore Chapman Foundation awarded SCS an extremely generous grant for our Tuition Assistance Program. These funds will assist several more families in need of financial support to allow their children to attend SCS. The need for these funds has been increasing yearly since the onset of the pandemic as many families continue to struggle with rising costs and economic uncertainty.

SCS was blessed to receive Covid-19 relief funding through **ARP EANS** (American Rescue Plan Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools) for ongoing intervention programs and tutoring for students and socio-emotional counseling for students, parents, and teachers.

SCS also received an award from Cal OES CSNSGP (California State Nonprofit Security Grant Program) for infrastructure protection, including security cameras and monitoring.

The Monterey Peninsula Foundation kindly donated funds to SCS again this year based on our volunteer efforts at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

The Concorso Italiano generously donated funds to SCS due to a strong volunteer turnout for last year's event.
